

POCKET MASK PATTERN

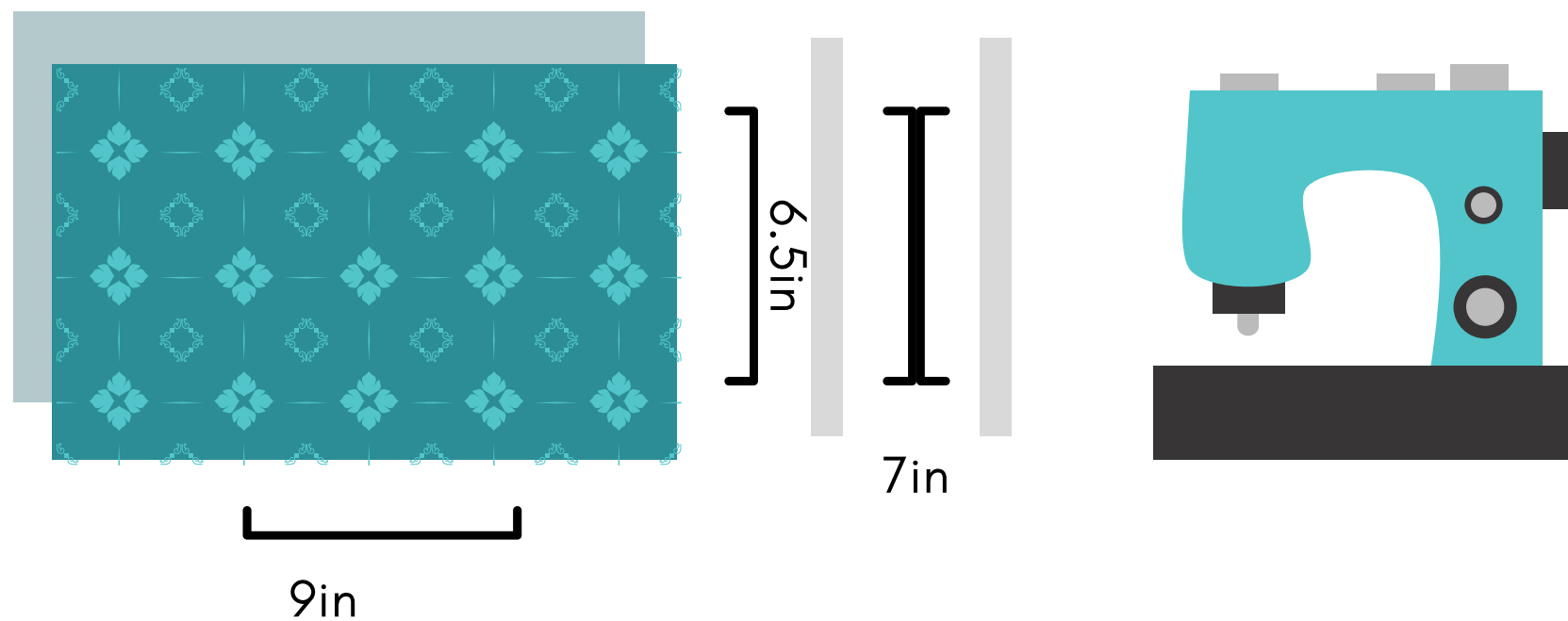


Flattening the curve, one stitch at a time.

Thank you so much for helping us make masks for healthcare facilities, social service organizations and other vulnerable communities in need. This is an easy and quick mask pattern that is good for any skill level.

Materials:

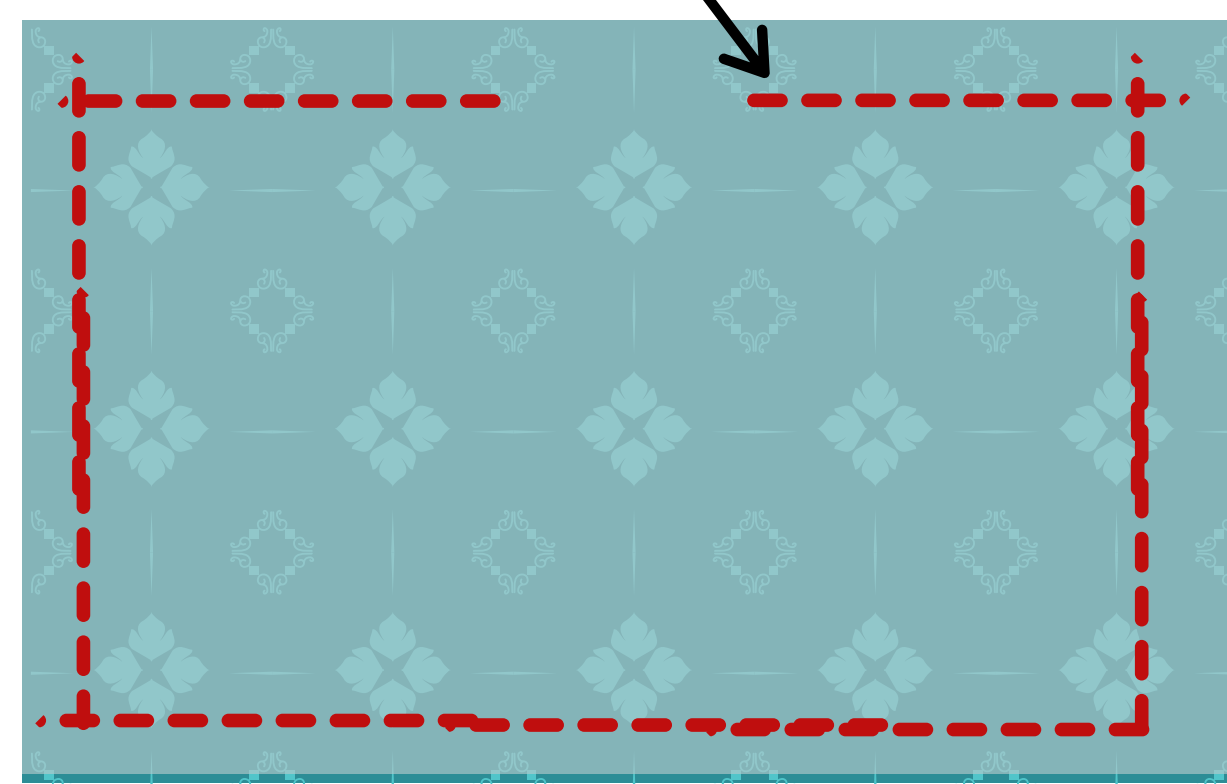
- (2) 9x6.5in pieces of fabric (if you can, use white or plain fabric on the inside)
- (2) 7in elastic straps



Step 1:

With the right sides together, begin sewing with a half inch seam allowance, starting about 4 inches from the edge of the short side of the fabric. Sew along the edge, and sew in the elastic at each corner.

Step 2:



Flip the mask right side out, and iron flat. Then, fold the mask to make two to three even pleats parallel with the long end of the fabric.



Step 3:
